POLICY STATEMENT

New Brunswick Community College (NBCC) recognizes the value of the establishment of a common division of the Academic Year.

PURPOSE

This will promote access to training activities and contribute to a more efficient and effective management of resources.

SCOPE AND LIMITATIONS

This policy applies to all programs across all campuses within NBCC.

1.0 DEFINITIONS

Academic Year

The Academic Year stretches over a twelve-month period from July 1st of one year to June 30th of the next year.

2.0 IMPLEMENTATION

NBCC adopts, for the purpose of its programs offering, an Academic Year model divided in four (4) Terms:

- a) **Summer Term** (July-August) of about ten (10) weeks duration
- b) **Fall Term** (September-December) of about fifteen (15) weeks duration
- c) **Winter Term** (January-Mid-April) of about fifteen (15) weeks duration
- d) **Spring Term** (Mid-April-June) of about ten (10) weeks duration

Traditionally, NBCC programs begin with the Fall Term. Some programs, however, may start at other terms.
