
Safety Sensitive Programs and Activities

1.0 HEALTH AND SAFETY OBLIGATIONS

Pursuant to the New Brunswick Occupational Health and Safety Act, New Brunswick Community College (NBCC) has a legal duty to “take every reasonable precaution to ensure the health and safety” at the College.

One measure to ensure this legal obligation includes the requirement for impairing prescription medication disclosure at NBCC. As per Article 2.1.1. h) of the **Student Code of Conduct**, students enrolled in a sensitive program or safety sensitive activity are required to disclose any prescribed medications that they understand to have the potential to cause impairment. Applicable students who are required to issue a disclosure will be obliged to direct their health care provider to complete and return to NBCC the **Prescription Medication – Impairment Risk Assessment Form**. Where applicable, NBCC will undertake to accommodate students, to the point of undue hardship, while ensuring obligations for health & safety are met.

A Safety Sensitive Activity involves a situation where an individual’s failure to perform the tasks required of the activity in a safe manner, due to impairment, would cause direct physical harm, injury, or death to the individual and/or their fellow students, faculty, staff, or members of the public.
