Inspect red	quired personal protective equipment and replace if required.

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4	Ensure machine is off.			
5	Inspect work area for safety hazards.			
6	Clean area if required.			
7	Perform pre- operational safety checks to ensure the machine is in safe working condition.			
8	Inspect blade type (job specific) and condition.			
9	If new band (blade) is needed please see safe work procedure for Band Welding.			
10	Use safe lifting procedures for loading parts and materials.			
11	Place workpiece on table.			
12	Adjust blade to allow approximately 1/8" clearance above workpiece.			
13	Clamp round or irregular materials to a flat material. CAUTION: Do not hold round or irregular shaped materials with your hands.			
14	Use a vice or appropriate holding material.			
15	Confirm workpiece is stable and there is no risk of the workpiece tilting-If unsure ask Instructor.			
16	Start saw blade, turn on coolant if required.			
17	Use push block to push work gently into the saw blade.			
18	When cut is completed, shut off machine and wait for the band to stop.			
19	Remove burrs from parts and cut offs (if required) using a file or grinder.			
20	Place left over material onto rack using safe lifting procedures.			
21	Complete Housekeeping activities.			
	If an emergency occurs while conducting this task, or there is an equipment malfunction, shut the equipment off immediately and follow the lock out procedure.
