Steps to be taken to complete task safely:				
1	Wear appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE).			
2	Examine work area and define equipment needed for the job.			
3	Ensure equipment is place on firm and level base.			
4	Provide adequate clearance space for equipment being used.			
5	Use safety harness if required for the job defined			
6	Use 3 points of contact when climbing up to a work platform			
7	Raise tools using a pully system if required			
8	Complete the job			
9	Lower tools using a pully system if required			
10	Climb down from the work platform ensuring all 3 points of contact			

12 Remove or dismantle equipment used to work at heights in the opposite order of erection of the equipment of immediately and follow the lock out procedure. REPORT ANY HAZARDOUS SITUATION TO YOUR INSTRUCTOR/SUPERVISOR IMMEDIATELY Housekeeping Place all equipment in their proper storage areas if job is complete. Ensure the equipment is safe, clean and tidy before you leave it. Remove and replace any damaged equipment and report immediately to your super
