

Safe Work Practice (SWP)

Department/Unit: Trades

Personal Protective Equipment or other required equipment or other safety considerations:

- Eye Protection Required
- Long or loose hair must be tied back or contained
- No loose-fitting clothing
- No jewelry, watches, rings, necklaces etc.
- Hearing Protection Required
- CSA Approved Safety Footwear required

Hazards:

- Noise
- **Cuts and Lacerations**

		Shop safety orientation	
		Read and understand SWP	
		For students, practical demonstration and Instructor supervision required	
Pre-Operational		Inspect required personal protective equipment and replace if required.	
Safety Checks		Inspect tool and ensure cutting blades are not chipped and sharp.	
		Ensure power cord is in good condition.	
		Ensure that power switch is OFF before plugging the tool in.	
		Check the material (stock) to ensure it is free of foreign objects (nails, screws, staples, etc.)	
Prohibited		Not Operating the tool with 2 hands.	
Activities		Do not cut stock less than 8" long or less than ½" thick.	
		Do not leave this equipment unattended while running.	
		Do not put your finger or any object in a deflector to clean out chips while a	
		planer is running.	
		Do not overreach. Keep proper footing and balance.	
Steps to be taken to complete task safely:			
1	Wear appr	opriate personal protective equipment (PPE).	
2	Make all adjustments to the cutter heads (blades) with POWER OFF. Don't plane more than 1/16" at a time.		
3	Ensure the material you are planing is supported and secured into a comfortable position.		
4	Start a cut with the infeed table (front shoe) resting firmly on the stock and with the cutter head slightly behind the edge of the stock.		
5		ands to operate a planer - one hand on the trigger switch and the other on a front	
J	handle	and to operate a planter - one mand on the trigger switch and the other on a nont	
6	Stand on the side of the planer near the controls. Never stand behind stock when being fed into the planer.

7	Keep all cords clear of cutting area.		
8	Disconnect the power supply and cleanup work area		
	Disseriment the pewer supply and dealing werk area		
9	During use, wood chips may need to be removed from the tool. To do this, unplug the tool. Once tool is cleaned, turn power on and resume from Step 4		
	If an emergency occurs while conducting this task, or there is an equipment malfunction, shut the equipment off immediately and follow the lock out procedure.
