Pre-Operational	•	Read and fully understand instructional manual before operating	
Safety Checks	•	Review rated capacities of said equipment	
	•	Locate and ensure Emergency Stop switch is operational	
	•	Ensure work area is free of clutter and any possible slip/trip hazards	
	•	Ensure there is no material or tools on / in the ironworker prior to start	
		up	
	•	Ensure all guarding is in place an functioning properly	
	•	Ensure all controls are operative	
	•	Foot pedals must be unobstructed	
	•	Ensure all accessories are fully fastened and secured	
	•	Examine punch, die, and stripper for correct alignment and securement	
	•	Ensure adequate lighting is provided	
Prohibited	•	Do Not operate this equipment without prerequisite training	
Activities	•	NEVER leave the machine running while unattended	
	•	NEVER punch holes thicker than the diameter of the punch	
	•	NEVER exceed machine rated capacities	
	•	Do Not leave material or hand tools on the workstation	
	•	Do Not operate this equipment without protective guarding or	
		strippers	
	•	NEVER attempt to punch partial holes.

	(Side thrust on punch / die assembly can be catastrophic.)				
Steps to be taken to complete task safely:					
1	Locate and inspect all required personal protective equipment. Replace if required.				
2	PPE must be worn at ALL times				
3	Task must be fully planned				
4	Complete material layout prior to any operation				
5	Select appropriate tooling required based on operation / material				
6	Turn on equipment				
7	Select correct machine operation with appropriate controls				
8	Operate machine with no load. (Dry Run)				
9	If a remote foot pedal is available, position it best suited to the task				
10	Ensure others are not in your work area				
11	Carefully place and support material in the machine				
12	Align material				
13	Keep hands clear				
14	Activate operation				
15	At the conclusion of a stroke, remove foot from pedal				
16	Remove all scrap material (exampleSlugs)
