Prohibited Activities	 Do not smoke (fire hazard). Never operate a damaged hoist. Never operate a hoist with non-operational locking devices. Do not leave this equipment unattended while running. Never lift a vehicle with someone inside. Never lift an unstable vehicle. Never work under a vehicle while hoist locks are off. Never work under a raised vehicle that's unstable. Steps to be taken to complete task safely:

2 Ma	Make all adjustments with POWER OFF.		
3 Ma	Make sure all guards are in place, properly adjusted, and secured.

6	Correctly position arms under vehicle as per manufacturer's procedures.			
7	Raise vehicle slightly (Just until wheels are off the floor) check for stability of vehicle.			
8	Make sure there are no people or objects in path of hoist. Follow manufacturer's procedures in operation of hoist.			
8	Clean up dust and debris with POWER OFF.
