Steps to be taken to complete task safely:				
1	Wear appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE).			
2	Ensure proper layout is done to mark cut lines prior to commencing cutting.			

Any document appearing in paper form is uncontrolled and must be compared to the electronic version.

Check blade and air filter before use and make all adjustments with engine OFF.

4	Ensure fuel levels adequate for the job being performed with the engine OFF.				
5	Ensure you are in a well-ventilated area and start the saw using the pull cord				
6	Hold the saw with 2 hands while using				
7	Press the throttle fully before starting a cut and place a clean water source near the blade. Start cutting with the bottom of the cutting wheel				
8	After the cut is complete, continue to run the throttle fully for 30 seconds to ensure the water has been thrown from the blade.				
	If an emergency occurs while conducting this task, or there is an equipment malfunction, shut the equipment off immediately and follow the lock out procedure.				
	REPORT ANY HAZARDOUS SITUATION TO YOUR INSTRUCTOR/SUPERVISOR IMMEDIATELY
