Pre-Operational Safety Checks		 Inspect required personal protective equipment and replace if required. Ensure no slip/trip hazards are present in workspaces and walkways. Make sure guards, if present, are installed and are working properly. Faulty equipment must not be used. Immediately report suspect machinery. Locate and ensure you are familiar with the operation of the ON/OFF starter. Disconnect power supply before adjusting equipment. 				
Prohibited Activities		 Do not Smoke (Fire Hazard) Do not leave this equipment unattended while running. 				
Steps to be taken to complete task safely:						
1	Inspect required personal protective equipment and replace if required					
2	Put on all required personal protective equipment. CAUTION: Do not spray people or self with this machine.					
3	Attach high pressure hose to outlet socket at front of machine					
4	Attach water hose to inlet socket at front of machine.					
5	Attach hose to water supply (taps)					
6	Attach spray gun to high pressure hose and secure.					
7	Plug machine in to wall socket if applicable					
8	Turn on water.					
9	Turn on power or start engine					

10	Adjust pressure and activate spray gun to remove air from pump and hose					
11	Adjust the amount of pressure needed for the type of task you are about to do. CAUTION: Do not use full power when using the pressure washer, it may damage some walls and floors. Adjust to proper pressure needed for each task.					
12	After finishing the task turn off machine.					
13	Turn off water					
14	Unplug machine from wall socket if applicable					
15	Press the spray gun handle to release the pressure from hose and machine.
