Steps to be taken to complete task safely:					
1	Wear appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE).				
2	Make all adjustments with POWER OFF.				
3	Visually inspect cabinet door, seal, and latch. All should be free from damage and be able to close tightly. Check exhaust fan operation and ensure that unit is properly grounded. If any deficiencies are spotted, let the instructor know immediately. Do not use.				
4	Inspect bead gun for proper grounding. Check gloves for tears or rips.				
5	Place hands in gloves, hold bead gun with one hand and the work piece with the other.				
6	Turn on sand blaster and perform operation				
7	Turn off unit and wait for dust to settle prior to opening door and removing work piece				
8	Clean up d	Clean up dust and debris with POWER OFF.			

If an emergency occurs while conducting this task, or there is an equipment malfunction, shut the equipment off immediately and follow the lock out procedure.
