Personal Protective Equipment or other required equipment or other safety considerations:

- Eye Protection Required

Required Training	 Successful completion of NBCC Safety Course (Work Safely or Workplace Safety Practices) Shop safety orientation Read and understand SWP For students, practical demonstration and Instructor supervision required 		
Pre-Operational Safety Checks	 Inspect required personal protective equipment and replace if required. Ensure no slip/trip hazards are present in workspaces and walkways. Make sure guards, if present, are installed and are working properly. Faulty equipment must not be used. Immediately report suspect machinery. Keep hands out of path of shear blades. Do not cut material larger than rated capacity. 		
Activities	 Do not remove finger guard. Keep hold-down adjusted as close as possible to the table, while providing clearance to feed material. Do not cut rod with the shear. Do not attempt to shear any material less than 1/2" cut across the table under full capacity. Never reach behind shear or allow someone to do so while operating equipment Never attempt to cut rod, strap or wire with this machine 		
Steps to be taken to complete task safely:			
	ropriate personal protective equipment (PPE).		
	Make sure all guards are in place, properly adjusted, and secured.		
3 Remove a	Remove all burrs from sheet metal before starting to work it.		
4 Place work	Place workpiece on table against guide and position it where cut is desired.		
5 Keep hand	Keep hands clear of the blade.		
6 Lower leve	Lower lever and apply enough force so that the blades cut through the workpiece		
7 Clean up work area.			

If an emergency occurs while conducting this task, or there is an equipment malfunction, shut the equipment off immediately and follow the lock out procedure.
